

The List McCarran Cargo Carriers

By January, Federal Express will be running its local cargo operations out of a new building at the Marnell Air Cargo Center, right, that replaces a cargo center that was demolished to make room for McCarran International Airport's new Terminal 3.

Marnell Air Cargo's two buildings will provide more than 200,000 square feet of warehouse space. The building FedEx will occupy is 78,936 square feet, while the larger second building will house Allegiant Air, ATS, United Parcel Service, Worldwide Flight Services, Southwest Airlines and US Airways cargo services.

The shells of both buildings are nearly complete and tenant improvement work will begin July 5. The first tenants are expected to move in October.

Total cost for the project, which sits on 19.15 acres, is \$29 million.
